



## UK / Scottish Tour May 30<sup>th</sup> – June 6<sup>th</sup> 2009

### **Tour Overview –**

- A classic tour starting from middle England, and riding up through the English heartland, passing through the classical Yorkshire dales national park, up in to the national parks in Cumbria and then North to Edinburgh, and onwards in to the Scottish highlands and the great West coast of Scotland.
- Time to explore Edinburgh; see some of the great sites that the city has to offer.
- Then North in to the Scottish highlands, then to Inverness, close to the famous – Loch Ness.
- Ride the Scottish West coast, and soak up the stunning countryside. Head South via the great lochs and in to Ayrshire.
- The ride back South will be highway riding, ending back Shakespeare country. Transfers back to Heathrow or extend your stay in London or visit some other parts of the UK.

### Key points –

### Tour summary –



**Day 1** – Saturday – Arrive Heathrow collected and transported to Warwick, heart of William Shakespeare country.

Collect bike, stay at the incredible and stunning 12<sup>th</sup> century English manor house hotel set in 500 acres of private grounds. This is a classic English heritage hotel. A real treat.

Dinner taken at the hotel.



**Day 2** – Sunday – Head North, past Birmingham and Manchester, heading towards the Yorkshire Dales National park. Ride through the park, and North to Cumbria, ride through the Cumbrian National park, keep heading North to Scotland, past Hadrian's wall, and in to the Scottish borders, and up to Edinburgh

Stay in Edinburgh

Distance ridden – 390 miles, or 580 KMS

**Day 3** – Free day to explore Edinburgh, visit the castle, visit a whiskey distillery

Stay – Edinburgh, no riding



**Day 4** – North, over the Firth of Forth bridge and up to Balmoral, the Scottish home of the Queen of England

Ride North up to Inverness

Stay outside Inverness next to a loch - in a Scottish castle. Dinner taken in the castle

Distance ridden – 185 miles, 290 KMS

**Day 5** – North from Inverness, and then a great West coast ride, taking in Ullapool, and then South and back to Inverness  
Stay – Same hotel as the previous night

Distance ridden – 150 miles, 225 KMS



**Day 6** – Inverness, South to loch Ness, and then South, ending up in Ayrshire, Stay in a manor house.



**Day 7** – Ayrshire, South down the motorway network to end up in Warwick, for farewell dinner, at the 1<sup>st</sup> hotel you started at.

Distance ridden – 320 miles, 480 KMS

**Total distance ridden – 1575 KMS or 1022 miles.**

**Extend your stay, visit London or rent a bike and explore other parts of the UK.**

- New BMW of your choice, see below, with luggage bags, for 6.5 days
- All mileage / KMS – up to 300 per day
- Collection from Heathrow and return to Heathrow airport
